Scott, Wolosiansky Lead Gulls to 6-1 Victory

Newport, RI-Troy Scott hit a two run home run in the second inning to give the Gulls a 2-1 lead, as they went on to win the game 6-1 over the Vermont Mountaineers.

Newport starter Dean Wolosiansky pitched well as he spread nine hits out over eight innings while only allowing one run to notch his third victory of the season. Wolosiansky also struck out five Mountaineer batters while just giving the free pass only twice. The lone run he gave up came in the first inning as Henry Dunn hit a leadoff double and then scored on a single off the bat of Ethan Paquette.

The Gulls added to their lead in the fifth inning when Joey Bergman hit a single which scored Greg Garcia.

In the seventh inning, the Gulls batters knocked Vermont's starter, Andrew Benak, out of the game after he got the first two outs fairly quickly. Newport hit three straight singles off of Benak, scoring a run in the process, thanks to a single by Bergman, before he was removed from the game.

Cole Shain came in and allowed two inherited runners to score on a two run single by Aaron Westlake to give Newport a 6-1 lead.

Matt Branham came in to close out the game in the ninth inning as the Gulls improved their record to 19-8.

The Gulls will play their next game against the Manchester Silkworms on Friday July 17. They will finish the suspended game from July 8 at 6:00. The Gulls will then play the make up game from June 20 at 7:00.

Newport will then return home for a double header against the Lowell All Americans on Monday July 20 at Cardines Field. The first game will begin at 3:00 as game two will begin 6:35.
